

<p>PATIENT PACKAGE INSERT IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PHARMACISTS' REGULATIONS (PREPARATIONS) – 1986</p> <p>The medicine is dispensed with a doctor's prescription only.</p> <h1>AGISPOR SHAMPOO</h1> <p>Each bottle contains: Bifonazole 1%</p> <p>Inactive ingredients and allergens in the preparation – see Section 6.</p> <p>Read this leaflet carefully in its entirety before using the medicine. This leaflet contains concise information about the medicine. If you have further questions, refer to the doctor or pharmacist.</p> <p>This medicine has been prescribed to treat you. Do not pass it on to others. It may harm them, even if it seems to you that their medical condition is similar.</p>	<p>The medicine is not intended for infants below the age of one month.</p> <p>1. WHAT IS THE MEDICINE INTENDED FOR?</p> <p>For the treatment of mycotic diseases of the scalp, such as pityriasis versicolor and seborrheic dermatitis.</p> <p>Therapeutic group</p> <p>An antifungal belonging to the family of imidazoles.</p> <p>2. BEFORE USING THE MEDICINE</p> <div> <p><input checked="" type="checkbox"/> Do not use the medicine:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> If you are sensitive (allergic) to the active ingredient or to any of the other ingredients found in the medicine. </div> <p>Special warnings regarding use of the medicine</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Do not use the medicine frequently, or for a long period, without consulting the doctor. 	<p>⚠Before beginning treatment with Agispor, tell the doctor if</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> you have a known sensitivity to antifungal medicines of the imidazole group such as: econazole, clotrimazole, miconazole. you are sensitive to any type of food or medicine. <p>⚠If you are taking, or have recently taken other medicines, including non-prescription medicines and nutritional supplements, tell the doctor or pharmacist. Especially inform the doctor or pharmacist if you are taking warfarin.</p> <p>⚠Pregnancy and breastfeeding</p> <p>Do not use the medicine if you are pregnant or breastfeeding, except with the explicit recommendation of the doctor.</p>	<p>⚠Use in children and infants</p> <p>Use in infants and toddlers must be under medical supervision.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> If there is no improvement in your condition within 6 weeks, refer to the doctor again. Avoid contact of the preparation with the eyes. <p>3. HOW SHOULD YOU USE THE MEDICINE?</p> <p>Always use according to the doctor's instructions. Check with the doctor or pharmacist if you are uncertain. The dosage and manner of treatment will be determined by the doctor only.</p> <p>Do not exceed the recommended dose. For external use only. Do not swallow. Shake before use.</p>	<p>If a child or anyone else has accidentally swallowed the medicine, proceed immediately to the doctor or a hospital emergency room and bring the package of the medicine with you.</p> <p>If you forgot to take the medicine do not take a double dose. Take the next dose at the scheduled time and consult the doctor. Adhere to the treatment regimen as recommended by the doctor. Even if there is an improvement in your health, do not stop treatment with the medicine without consulting the doctor or pharmacist.</p> <p>Method of use in the absence of other instructions from the doctor:</p> <p>Use for 4 weeks. The recommended dosage is 3 times a week. At every shampooing, the scalp should be shampooed</p>	<p>twice. Shake the bottle well, apply a measured amount of shampoo to the hair or affected area of the skin and leave the shampoo on the scalp for 5 minutes before washing off. Use a sufficient quantity of shampoo to ensure good foaming of the shampoo.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Do not take medicines in the dark! Check the label and the dose <u>each time</u> you take the medicine. Wear glasses if you need them. <p>If you have further questions regarding use of the medicine, consult the doctor or pharmacist.</p> <p>4. SIDE EFFECTS</p> <p>As with any medicine, use of Agispor Shampoo may cause side effects in some users. Do not be alarmed by reading the list of side effects. You may not suffer from any of them.</p> <p>Known side effects</p>	<p>associated with the use of Bifonazole:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Reactions on the skin and subcutaneous tissue: Contact dermatitis, allergic skin inflammation, reddening, itching, rash, urticaria, blistering, peeling of the skin, eczema, dry skin, skin irritation, softening of the skin, and burning sensation. Pain and/or edema in the treated area. <p>These side effects disappear after cessation of treatment, however if these effects persist and/or are bothersome, refer to the doctor.</p> <p>If any of the side effects worsen, or if you suffer from a side effect that is not mentioned in the leaflet, consult with the doctor.</p> <p>5. HOW SHOULD THE MEDICINE BE STORED?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Avoid poisoning! This medicine, and any 	<p>other medicine, should be kept in a closed place out of the sight and reach of children and/or infants in order to avoid poisoning. Do not induce vomiting without explicit instructions from the doctor.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Do not use the medicine after the expiry date (exp. date) appearing on the package. The expiry date refers to the last day of that month. Can be used for 6 months after first opening. Store in a cool place below 25°C. Store in the original packaging. <p>6. FURTHER INFORMATION</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> In addition to the active ingredient, the medicine also contains: Sodium lauryl sulphate, sodium lauryl ether sulphate, ethyl alcohol, lactic acid, cocamide diethanolamine, 	<p>cocamidopropylamine oxide, Perfume 199-95, purified water.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> What does the medicine look like and what are the contents of the package: A plastic bottle containing 100 milliliters of Agispor Shampoo. Name of manufacturer and registration holder: Perrigo Israel Pharmaceuticals Ltd., P.O.B. 16, Yeruham. This leaflet was checked and approved by the Ministry of Health in August 2014.
