Tablets

Composition:

Each tablet contains:

Pyridoxine Hydrochloride 300 mg

Inactive Ingredients:

Amylum, Povidone, Powdered Cellulose, Sodium Starch Glycolate, Magnesium Stearate, Colloidal Silicon Dioxide, Yellow No. 6 lake, Blue No. 2 lake.

Therapeutic activity:

Vitamin B₆ supplement.

When not to use this medicine?

Do not use if you are sensitive to any of the components of this medicine.

Do not start to use this medicine without first consulting your physician: If you are pregnant or breastfeeding.

Warnings:

Do not use this medicine frequently or for a prolonged period without consulting your physician. If you are sensitive to any kind of food or drugs, inform

your physician before taking this medicine.

Taking an inordinate dose is likely to cause harm to the nervous system.

Drug interactions:

If you are taking another drug concomitantly, or if you have just finished treatment with another medicine, inform the treating physician in order to prevent hazards or inefficacy arising from drug interactions, especially for drugs of the following groups: levodopa (parkinson's), hydralazine (for blood pressure), contraceptive pills, immunosuppressants, such as: corticosteroids, cyclosporins (for transplants), isoniazid (for tuberculosis), penicillamine (for poisoning).

Side effects:

In addition to the desired effect of the medicine, unwanted side effects may also appear during treatment.

Side effects that require special attention:

Skin irritation or eruption: stop the treatment and refer to the physician.

If at any time you experience side effects that are not mentioned in this leaflet or if you feel an adverse change in your general well-being, consult your physician immediately.

Dosage:

As directed by the physician only Do not exceed the recommended dosage.

<u>Prevent poisoning!</u>
This medicine, like all medicines, should be kept in a closed cupboard, out of the reach of children and/or infants in order to prevent poisoning.

If you took an overdose or if a child accidentally swallowed

some of the medicine, go immediately to the emergency room of a hospital and bring with you any remaining medicine and the original packaging.

Do not induce vomiting without explicit instructions from

the physician!

This medicine was prescribed to treat your ailment; in another patient it may be harmful. Do not give this medicine to your relatives, neighbours or acquaintances.

Do not take any medicine in the dark! Carefully check the label and dose <u>each time</u> you take the medicine. Wear your glasses if you need them.

Storage:

Store below 25°C.

Even if stored according to the manufacturer's recommendations, all medicines have a limited shelf life. Please pay attention to the expiry date of the medicine. If you have any doubts, please consult the dispensing pharmacist.

Do not store different medicines in the same container.
