The dispensing of this medicine requires a doctor's prescription.
Read the package insert carefully in its entirety before using this medicine.

DORZOLAMIDE TIMOLOL TEVA® Eye Drops

COMPOSITION

Each ml contains:
 Dorzolamide (as hydrochloride) 20 mg (2%)
 Timolol (as maleate) 5 mg (0.5%)

Inactive Ingredients

Mannitol, hydroxyethyl cellulose, sodium citrate dihydrate, benzalkonium chloride, sodium hydroxide, water for injection.

Note: This product contains benzalkonium chloride 0.0075% (0.147 mg per ml), which may be deposited in soft contact lenses (See also "Warnings").

THERAPEUTIC GROUP

Inhibitor of the carbonic anhydrase enzyme group (dorzolamide) in combination with a beta blocker (timolol).

THERAPEUTIC ACTIVITY

For the reduction of elevated intraocular pressure and for the treatment of glaucoma.

WHEN SHOULD THE PREPARATION NOT BE USED?

Do not use this medicine if you are sensitive to any of its ingredients.
 Do not use this medicine if you are suffering or have suffered in the past from asthma, obstructive pulmonary disease, heart failure, slow heart rate (bradycardia), or severe kidney problems.
 Do not use this medicine if you are taking oral carbonic anhydrase inhibitors.
 Do not use this medicine if you are breastfeeding.

Do not take this medicine without consulting a doctor before starting treatment if you are pregnant/plan to become pregnant, if you are suffering or have suffered in the past from impaired function of the respiratory system, the heart, the eyes (e.g. corneal defects), history of eye surgery, the liver, the kidney, the thyroid gland (abrupt withdrawal of treatment may exacerbate the symptoms of hyperthyroidism), diabetes or have suffered spontaneous hypoglycemia (low blood sugar), history of allergic problems, including eczema, hives (pinkish, itchy swellings on the skin), hay fever, or muscle weakness (myasthenia gravis).

HOW WILL THIS MEDICINE AFFECT YOUR DAILY LIFE?

Use of this medicine may cause drowsiness/blurring of vision or (double vision). Caution should therefore be exercised when engaging in activities such as driving a car, operating dangerous machinery, and any other activity which requires mental alertness and/or visual acuity.

WARNINGS

Intraocular pressure tests should be performed during treatment with this medicine.

If you are sensitive to any type of food or medicine, especially beta-blockers, or sulfonamide derivatives, please inform your doctor before commencing treatment with this medicine. If you plan on having any type of surgery including eye surgery, you should tell your doctor that you are using this medicine.

This product contains benzalkonium chloride as a preservative, which may be deposited in soft contact lenses. Therefore this product should not be used while wearing these lenses. The lenses should be removed before using the drops and should not be reinserted earlier than 15 minutes at least after instillation of the drops into the eyes. If you are using another topical ophthalmic medication or in the event you are instructed to use an additional topical ophthalmic medication, allow an interval of at least 10 minutes between the use of the medication and the instillation of Dorzolamide Timolol Teva eye drops. If during treatment with this medicine you are exposed to ocular damage, such as trauma, infection, or ocular surgery, you should immediately seek your doctor's advice regarding the continued use of the medicine. If during treatment with this medicine eye irritation or any other new eye problem develops such as redness of the eye or swelling of the eyelids, refer to your doctor immediately.

If you suspect that the product is causing an allergic reaction (e.g., skin rash or itching), stop its use and contact your doctor immediately.

DRUG INTERACTIONS

If you are taking another drug concomitantly, or if you have just finished treatment with another medicine, including other ophthalmic medicines, and medicines obtained without prescription, you must inform the attending doctor in order to prevent hazards or lack of efficacy arising from drug interactions.

This is especially important for medicines belonging to the following groups: aspirin in high doses, antihypertensive drugs (e.g. as clonidine), anti-asthmatic medications, medicines for heart disease (e.g. guanidine, dioxin), medicines for the treatment of glaucoma especially those belonging to carbonic anhydrase inhibitors, oral beta blockers (e.g. propranolol), calcium channel blockers (e.g. nifedipine), antidepressants belonging to SSRI group (e.g. fluoxetine), injectable epinephrine.

SIDE EFFECTS

In addition to the desired effect of the

medicine, adverse reactions may occur during the course of taking this medicine, for example: burning, stinging and dryness of the eye, blurred vision/visual changes, redness of the eye, itching, tearing, feeling of the presence of foreign body in the eye, headache, nosebleed, dry mouth, dizziness, fatigue, ringing or buzzing in the ears, anesthesia; nausea, vomiting, diarrhea, irregular heartbeat and a slowing of your heart rate, numbness or tingling in the fingers or toes, hair loss or thinning, bitter taste in the mouth.

Effects that require special attention

Conjunctivitis and keratitis, inflammation of the eyelids (swelling, crustiness and irritation); symptoms of hypersensitivity to the drug such as edema in the face and throat accompanied by difficulties in breathing and swallowing, urticaria and itching, asthenia (weakness) or increased fatigue, fever accompanied with sore throat, muscle or joint pain (rare): stop treatment and refer to the doctor immediately!

Eye infection, eye injury (rare): stop treatment and refer to your doctor immediately!

Chest pain, edema, dizziness, confusion, diarrhea, blurred vision, skin rash (rare): refer to your doctor immediately!

In the event that you experience side effects not mentioned in this leaflet, or if there is a change in your general health, consult your doctor immediately.

DOSAGE

According to doctor's instructions only. Recommended dosage unless otherwise prescribed by your doctor: 1 drop to be instilled in the affected eye in the morning and 1 drop in the evening.

Do not exceed the recommended dosage.

This medicine is not usually intended for administration to infants and children.

This medicine is to be taken at specific time intervals as determined by the attending doctor.

If you forget to use this medicine at the specified time, instill the dose as soon as you remember. However, if it is almost time for the next dose, skip the missed dose and resume your regular dosing schedule.

ATTENTION!

Do not swallow! This medicine is intended for external use only.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Wash your hands thoroughly. Tilt back your head or lie down on a bed and with the aid of a finger pull the lower eyelid slightly away from the eye. Instill the medicine into the gap and keep your eyes closed for 1-2 minutes. Try not to blink.

To prevent contamination of eye drops, take care not to allow the tip of the bottle to come into contact with any surface including the finger and the eye itself, and close the bottle tightly after use.

HOW CAN YOU CONTRIBUTE TO THE SUCCESS OF THE TREATMENT?

Complete the full course of treatment as instructed by the doctor.

Even if there is an improvement in your health, do not discontinue use of this medicine before consulting your doctor.

Avoid Poisoning!

This medicine, and all other medicines, must be stored in a safe place out of the reach of children and/or infants, in order to avoid poisoning.

If you have taken an overdose, or if a child has accidentally swallowed the medicine, proceed immediately to a hospital emergency room and bring the package of the medicine with you. Do not induce vomiting unless explicitly instructed to do so by a doctor! This medicine has been prescribed for the treatment of your ailment; in another patient it may cause harm.

Do not give this medicine to your relatives, neighbours or acquaintances.

Do not take medicines in the dark! Check the label and the dose each time you take your medicine. Wear glasses if you need them.

STORAGE

Store this medicine below 25°C, in a dark place. Do not refrigerate or freeze. Close firmly to prevent penetration of air.

Do not use this medicine for more than one month after the bottle is first opened.

Even if kept in their original container and stored as recommended, medicines may be kept for a limited period only. Please note the expiry date of the medicine! In case of doubt, consult the pharmacist who dispensed the medicine to you.

Do not store different medications in the same package.
