improve after 3 days. 1. What is the medicine intended for? Strefen is intended for the short-term relief of symptoms of sore throat such as throat soreness and swelling in adults and children

over 12 years of age. Therapeutic group- The active ingredient in this medicine is flurbiprofen, which belongs to the Non-Steroidal Anti-Inflammatory Drugs (NSAIDs) group. This group of substances provides relief by changing the body's reaction to

pain, swelling and high fever. Before using the medicine
 Do not use the preparation if:

you are hypersensitive (allergic) to flurbiprofen or any of the other ingredients this medicine contains (see section 6) you suffer or have suffered in the past from recurrent peptic ulcer (2 or more episodes of a proved peptic ulcer), or gastrointestinal bleeding

you have experienced hypersensitivity in the past (such as: asthma, bronchospasm, rhinitis, angioedema or urticaria) after using aspirin or other NSAIDs.

you have suffered from gastrointestinal bleeding or perforation, severe colitis (inflammation of the intestines) or bleeding while taking other NSAIDs.
you take other NSAIDs (such as celecoxib, ibuprofen, diclofenac sodium, etc.) or a dosage of aspirin that exceeds

you suffer from severe heart failure, severe liver failure or

severe kidney failure. you are in the last trimester of pregnancy. you are under 12 years of age Special warnings regarding the use of this medicine:

you have suffered in the past from gastrointestinal diseases such as ulcerative colitis, Crohn's disease. you suffer from a chronic autoimmune disease (such as systemic lupus or mixed connective tissue disease)

Adults, the elderly and children over 12 years of age: The recommended dosage is one lozenge to be sucked on or dissolved in your mouth every 3-6 hours. Suck on the lozenge slowly, while slowly moving it around the inside of your mouth in order to prevent local irritation. **Do not use more than 5**

lozenges in a 24-hour period. Do not exceed the recommended dose. This medicine is not intended for infants and children under 12 years of age This medication is for short-term use only. Take the lowest possible effective dose for the shortest time necessary to relieve your symptoms. If you feel irritation in your mouth, discontinue use of the medicine

Do not take this medicine for more than 3 days, unless instructed to do so by a doctor. If there is no improvement in your condition within 3 days, or if your condition worsens, or if you suffer from new symptoms, refer to your doctor. If you have accidently taken an overdose, you may feel drowsy or nauseous.

If you have taken an overdose or if a child has accidently swallowed the medicine, proceed immediately to a doctor or hospital emergency room and bring the medicine's package with you, even if you feel well. If you forgot to take this medicine at the required time, do not

take a double dose, take the next dose at the usual time and do not exceed the recommended dose If you have further questions about the use of this medicine, consult your doctor or pharmacist. 4. Side effects

Like every medicine, the use of Strefen may cause side effects in some users. Do not be alarmed while reading the list of side
