

## **Consumer leaflet for a Veterinary Product**

This medicine is marketed according to a veterinarian's prescription only.  
For animal use only

### **1. Name of the veterinary medicine, form and strength**

NEOGAL VETERINARY, powder for solution in drinking water Per os

### **2. Active ingredient and quantity in a single dose**

Neomycin Sulfate 100%

### **3. What is the medicine intended for**

For the treatment of gastro-intestinal tract infections and diarrhea caused by gram negative bacteria as salmonella, E. coli and other bacteria sensitive to neomycin in turkeys.

Therapeutic group: antibiotic belonging to the aminoglycoside group.

### **4. Contraindications**

- Do not use the product in breeding flocks.
- Do not inject! The product is for oral administration only.
- Do not use in animals with hypersensitivity to neomycin or to antibiotics of the aminoglycoside group.
- Do not use in animals with intestinal obstruction.

### **5. Side effects**

### **6. Target animals:** Turkeys.

### **7. Dosage and administration**

1 gram for 10 - 15 Litres of drinking water for 5 days or according to the instructions of the attending veterinarian.

### **8. How to use the product**

For use in drinking water. Prepare fresh solution every 24 hours.

### **9. Withdrawal period**

Treatment should be finalized 24 hours before slaughter.

### **10. Warnings**

- Special warnings regarding the use of the medicine in target animal  
ill animals have decreased appetite and different drinking pattern, therefore very ill animals might need parenteral treatment.
- Special warnings regarding the safe use of the medicine in animals
  - The powder is designed to dissolve in water and should not be used as is.

- The medicine should be used based on a microbiological sensitivity test of isolated bacteria from the animal, or based on regional epidemiological information. Using the product not according to the instructions in the leaflet can cause an increase in the presence of bacteria resistant to neomycin and reduce the effectiveness of the treatment with drugs from the aminoglycoside family due to the potential for cross-resistance.
- Special warnings regarding the safety for the person administering the veterinary medicinal product to animals
  - Wash hands after use.
  - People with known hypersensitivity to aminoglycosides should avoid contact with Neogal Veterinary. If symptoms such as a skin rash appear, consult a doctor. Swelling of the face, lips or eyes, or breathing difficulties are more serious signs and urgent medical attention should be sought.
- Pregnancy and lactation in target animals  
Do not use the product in breeding flocks.
- Drug interactions and other types of interactions  
General anesthetics and muscle relaxants can increase the neurologic blocking effect of aminoglycosides. This can cause paralysis and respiratory arrest. Special care should be taken when used simultaneously with strong diuretics and ototoxic substances or potential nephrotoxics.
- Overdose  
Nephrotoxic and ototoxic effects can occur in case of overdose.
- Incompatibility  
In the absence of studies on the subject, this drug should not be mixed with other veterinary drugs.

#### **11. Storage instructions**

- Avoid poisoning! This medicine, and any other medicine, must be kept in a closed place outside the reach and sight of children and/or infants to prevent accidental poisoning.
- Do not use the medicine after its expiration date (exp. date) as it appears on the package. The expiration date refers to the last day of the stated month.
- Storage conditions: below 25°C.

#### **12. Instructions for disposing of the product / remaining product at the end of its use**

Any residue of a veterinary medical product or any waste obtained from the use of a veterinary medical product should be disposed of as toxic waste, do not throw into the sewage system.

- What does the medicine look like and what is the content of the package : white to yellowish powder
- Package sizes: glass bottle: 50 grams , 100 grams; Jar :100 grams; laminated bag: 200 grams.
