1. what Alcosept is used for?

This medicine is indicated for skin
disinfection.

Therapeutic Group

Antiseptic preparations (disinfectants)

2. Before using the preparation

Do not use the medicine:

- If you are sensitive (allergic) to the active substance or to any of the additional ingredients contained in the medicine. For the list of the inactive substances – see Section 6 "Additional Information"

Special warnings concerning use of the medicine:

- Avoid contact with the eyes. In case of contact, rinse thoroughly with water.
- If you are sensitive to any food or medicine, inform your physician before using this medicine.

• Alcohol is a flammable substance. Do not light a cigarette or expose yourself to an open flame until the preparation is fully dried.

If you are taking, or recently took, other medicines, including over the counter medicines and dietary supplements, inform your doctor or pharmacist.

3. Directions for Use

Manner of use:

Ask your doctor or pharmacist if you are not sure how to use it.

Dosage: the general recommended dosage is whenever required.

Wipe the area to be disinfected with cotton wool soaked in the alcohol.

Do not exceed the recommended dosage.

Do not swallow. For external use only.

If you have taken an overdose or if a child has accidentally swallowed the medicine, proceed immediately to a doctor or a hospital emergency room and bring the Alcosept package with you.

Do not take medicines in the dark!

Check the label and the dose each time you take your medicine. Wear glasses if you need them.

If you have further questions concerning use of the preparation, refer to your doctor or pharmacist.

4. Side Effects:

As for any medicine, the use of Alcohol may cause side effects in some users.

Do not be alarmed by the list of side effects. You will probably not suffer from any of them.

If a side effect appears, consult your doctor.

5. How to store the medicine?

• Avoid poisoning!

This medicine, and all other medicine, must be stored in a safe place out of the reach of children and/or infants, in order to avoid poisoning.

Do not induce vomiting unless explicitly instructed to do so by the doctor.

• Do not use the medicine after the exp. date appearing on the package.

The expiry date refers to the last day of that month.

• Store in a cool place, below 25°C.

• Close tightly.

• **Warning!** Flammable substance, keep away from fire.

• Store in the original package.

• You can use the product after opening until its expiry date.
