FOR? · This medicine is intended to treat

secondary hyperparathyroidism in patients with serious kidney disease who need dialysis to clear their blood of waste products.

- To reduce hypercalcemia (high levels of calcium in the blood) in patients with parathyroid cancer. To reduce high levels of calcium in the blood (hypercalcemia) in patients with primary hyperparathyroidism when removal of the gland is not possible.
- Therapeutic group: The medicine controls the levels of

calcium and has anti-parathyroid activity. It is used to treat ailments caused by impaired function of organs called the parathyroid glands.
