The medicine is dispensed without a doctor's prescription

Cream

Composition

Cetrimide 0.5% w/w

Chlorhexidine Hydrochloride 0.1% w/w

For information about inactive and allergenic ingredients, see section 2 - "Important information about some of the ingredients of the medicine" and section 6 - "Further Information".

Read the leaflet carefully in its entirety before using the medicine. This leaflet contains concise information about the medicine. If you have further questions, refer to the doctor or pharmacist.

Use the preparation according to the instructions in the dosage section of this leaflet. Consult with the pharmacist if you require further information. Refer to the doctor if symptoms of the illness worsen or if they do not improve.

1. WHAT IS THE MEDICINE INTENDED FOR?

First aid antiseptic, for external use in minor injuries, wounds and burns.

Therapeutic group:

Antiseptics

Chlorhexidine is an antiseptic with a broad spectrum of activity against microorganisms, including bacteria, fungi and viruses.

Cetrimide has antiseptic characteristics.

2. BEFORE USING THE MEDICINE

Do not use the medicine if:

- Do not use this medicine if you have known sensitivity to any of the ingredients of the medicine, especially to chlorhexidine, which could cause an allergic reaction. Cetostearyl alcohol could cause a local skin reaction.
- Do not use this preparation in the mouth and eye area.
- Do not use the preparation in the middle ear.

Special warnings regarding use of Savior:

- If you are sensitive to any food or medicine, inform the doctor of this before using the medicine.
- Do not use this preparation frequently or for a long period without consulting a doctor.
- In cases in which swelling develops in the wound, or the wound is accompanied by fever, consult a doctor.

Drug interactions:

If you are taking, or have recently taken, other medicines, including non-prescription medicines and nutritional supplements, tell the doctor or pharmacist.

Avoid using soap and other anionic agents.

Bleaches, containing hypochloride, may cause brown stains to appear on fabrics that have previously been in contact with Savior.

Important information about some of the ingredients of the medicine:

Cetostearyl alcohol could cause an allergic reaction.

3. HOW SHOULD YOU USE THE MEDICINE?

Check with the doctor or pharmacist if you are uncertain regarding the dosage and treatment regimen of the preparation.

Directions for use:

For external use only. Do not swallow!

Spread the cream in a thin layer on the affected area.

Avoid contact of the medicine with the eyes. In case of contact with the eyes, rinse them well with water.

If you took an overdose, or if a child has accidentally swallowed the medicine, refer immediately to a doctor or proceed to a hospital emergency room, and bring the package of the medicine with you.

Do not use the medicine in the dark! Check the label and the dose each time you take medicine.

Wear glasses if you need them.

If you have further questions regarding use of the medicine, consult the doctor or pharmacist.

4. SIDE EFFECTS

As with any medicine, use of Savior may cause side effects in some users. Do not be alarmed when reading the list of side effects. You may not suffer from any of them.

Stop using the medicine and refer to the doctor immediately if:

You experience any of the following very rare allergic reactions:

Breathing difficulties, swelling of the face, tongue or throat, dizziness, skin irritation or rash.

If a side effect occurs, if one of the side effects worsens or if you suffer from a side effect not mentioned in this leaflet, consult with the doctor.

5. HOW SHOULD THE MEDICINE BE STORED?

Avoid poisoning! This medicine, and any other medicine, should be kept in a safe place out of the reach and sight of children and/or infants in order to avoid poisoning. Do not induce vomiting unless explicitly instructed to do so by a doctor.

Do not use the medicine after the expiry date (exp. date) that appears on the package. The expiry date refers to the last day of that month.

Storage conditions: Store this medicine below 25°C.

6. FURTHER INFORMATION

In addition to the active ingredients, the medicine also contains:

Purified water, Cetostearyl alcohol, Mineral oil (paraffin oil).

What the medicine looks like and contents of the package:

An aluminum tube containing a white, smooth cream with a uniform texture without lumps.

Marketed in a 10 gram tube.
