ALCOSEPT

Solution

Composition:

Active substances and their concentration:

Chlorhexidine Gluconate 0.5%

Alcohol 70%

For the list of the inactive substances:

See Section 6 "Additional information".
Read the leaflet carefully to the end
before using the medication.

This leaflet contains abridged
information on the preparation.

Use the preparation correctly.

1. What Alcosept is used for?

This medicine is indicated for skin disinfection.

Therapeutic Group - Antiseptic solutions.

2. Before using the preparation

Do not use the medicine:

- If you have known sensitivity (are allergic) to the active substances or to any of the additional ingredients contained in the medicine. For the list of the inactive substances - see Section 6 "Additional information".
- On the brain tissues, meninges and middle ear.
- In infants less than two month of age.

Special warnings concerning use of the medicine:

- Avoid contact with the eyes. In case of contact, rinse thoroughly with water.
- If you are sensitive to any food or medicine, inform your physician before using this medicine.
- The use of the medicine does not constitute an alternative to sterile gloves.
- Do not light a cigarette or expose yourself to an open flame until the preparation is fully dried.

If you are taking, or recently took, other medicines, including over the counter medicines and dietary supplements, inform your doctor or pharmacist.

Important information about some of the drug ingredients:

Contains alcohol, flammable substance.

3. Directions for Use

Ask your doctor or pharmacist if you are not sure.

Do not exceed the recommended dosage. Do not swallow. For external use only.

Manner of use:

Swab the area to be disinfected with cotton wool soaked in liquid Alcosept whenever required.

If you have taken an overdose or if a child has accidentally swallowed the medicine, proceed immediately to a doctor or a hospital emergency room and bring the Alcosept package with you.

Do not take medicines in the dark!

Check the label and the dose each time you take your medicine. Wear glasses if you need them.

If you have further questions concerning use of the preparation, refer to your doctor or pharmacist.

4. Side Effects:

As for any medicine, the use of Alcosept may cause side effects in some users.

Do not be alarmed by the list of side effects. You will probably not suffer from any of them.

Stop treatment and refer to your doctor:

- In case of skin sensitivity (rare)
- In case of prolonged irritation or swelling (rare)

Other Side Effects:

Rash, redness and local irritation.

If one of the side effects becomes more serious, or if you suffer from a side effect not mentioned in the leaflet, consult your doctor.

Side Effects in Children:

Parents must inform the attending physician of any side effect and any other medicine being taken by the child. See above for details of special side effects.

5. How to store the medicine?

• **Avoid poisoning!**

This medicine, and all other medicine, must be stored in a safe place out of the reach of children and/or infants, in order to avoid poisoning.

Do not induce vomiting unless explicitly instructed to do so by the doctor.

- Do not use the medicine after the exp. date appearing on the package.

The expiry date refers to the last day of that month.

- Store at room temperature, below 25°C.

- Close tightly.

- **Warning!** Flammable substance, keep away from fire.

- Store in the original package.

- After the initial opening of the bottle it may be used for a period of 3 months, but no later than the expiry date of the preparation.

6. Additional information

In addition to the active substances the drug also contains

Tartrazine, Purified water

Appearance of the drug and contents of the package Yellow-colored alcohol solution.

Contents: 100 mL, 300 mL, 500 mL, 1000 mL.
