ANTIBACTERIAL SKIN CLEANSER

Patient package insert in accordance with the Pharmacists' Regulations (Preparations) 1986.
No doctor's prescription is needed for this medicine. The format of this bulletin was determined by the Ministry of Health who has reviewed and approved its content.

Active Ingredient: Triclosan 1%.

Non-active and allergenic Ingredients in the preparation:

See paragraph 6.

Read this leaflet carefully in its entirety before using this medicine.

This leaflet contains essential information about the medicine. If you have additional questions, consult your doctor or a pharmacist.

You must use this medicine in a proper manner:

- Consult your pharmacist if you need additional information.
- Inform your doctor if the infection's symptoms worsen or will not get better after a few days use.

1. Therapeutic Activity:

For treatment and disinfection of skin infections.
Therapeutic Group: Antiseptic substances (disinfectants).

2. Before using the medicine:

Do not use the medicine if:

you are sensitive (allergic) to the active ingredient or to any of the other ingredients of the medicine. See the list of additional ingredients in paragraph 6 "Additional information".

If you are sensitive to a particular food or medicine, you should report this fact to your doctor before commencing treatment with this medicine.

Special warnings concerning the use of the medicine:

• If you are taking another drug concomitantly or if you have just finished treatment with another medicine, including non prescription medicines or food supplements, inform the doctor or the pharmacist in order to prevent hazards or lack of efficacy arising from drug interactions.

• **Avoid contact with eyes:** In case of accidental contact with the eyes, rinse out immediately with water.

• In cases of prolonged use on babies under 6 months old, consult your doctor.

• **Pregnancy and breastfeeding:** If you are pregnant or breastfeeding, consult a doctor or a pharmacist before you begin using the medicine.

3. How to use the medicine?

Consult your doctor or pharmacist if you have any doubts.

Attention: Do not swallow! This medicine is intended for external use only.

Directions for use: Wet the skin. Apply a small amount of Dermalin. Lather and rinse off thoroughly from the skin. Do not allow a prolonged contact with skin.

Do not take this medicine in the dark! Check the label and dose each time you use your medicine. Wear glasses if you need them.

4. Side Effects:

• Like in other drugs, using Dermalin may cause some side effects to appear for some of the users. No need to be alarmed while reading the side effects list. You probably will not suffer from any of them.

• **Discontinue use and consult your doctor immediately** in rare cases of irritation, local rash or inflammation (that did not occur before using Dermalin).

• If you experience any side effects that are not listed in this leaflet or if one of the side effects is getting worse, consult your doctor.

5. How to store the medicine?

• **Avoid Poisoning!** This medicine like all other medicines, must be stored in a safe place and out of the reach of children and/or infants, to avoid poisoning. If a child has accidentally swallowed the medicine, proceed immediately to a hospital emergency room and bring the package of the medicine with you. **Do not induce vomiting** unless explicitly instructed to do so by a doctor!

• Use within 12 months after opening. Do not use the medicine after the expiry date printed on the package. The expiry date is always the last day of that month.

• Do not store over 25°C.

• Always keep in the original package.

6. Additional information

• Besides the active ingredient, the medicine contains: Purified Water, Sodium Laureth Sulfate, Cocamide DEA, Ethoxylated Lanolin, Glycol Stearate, Fragrance, Phenylethanol, Citric Acid, Disodium EDTA, Sodium Chloride.

• How does the medicine look like and what are the contents of the bottle? A yellowish colour emulsion with a lemon scent, in a 200 gram bottle with a pressure screw cap / a 500 gram bottle with a pump.
