Adults and children 12 years of age and above:

1-2 personal packs of Avcamol 500 mg every 4-6 hours, as needed. Do not take more than 8 personal packs in 24 hours (4 grams paracetamol). Children 6-12 years of age:

One personal pack of Avcamol 500 mg every 4-6 hours, as needed.

Do not take more than 4 personal packs in 24 hours (2 grams paracetamol).

Directions for use

Do not take with food. Open the Avcamol 500 mg personal pack, empty its contents directly into the mouth, onto the tongue, and swallow. There is no need for water.

In the resist of developing severe liver to the risk of developing severe liver damage. Overdose may cause the following symptoms: nausea and vomiting, diarrhea, loss of appetite, vomiting, diarrhea, loss of appetite, abdominal pains, flatulence, increased sweating, pain or tenderness in the upper abdomen. 5. HOW SHOULD THE MEDICINE **BE STORED?**

Avoid poisoning! This medicine, and any other medicine, must be kept in a safe place out of the reach of children and/or infants in order to avoid poisoning. Do not induce avoid poisoning. Do not induce vomiting without explicit instruction from the doctor.

Do not use the medicine after the expiry date (Exp. Date) appearing on the package. The expiry date refers to the last day of that month.

Store below 25°C in the original package, to protect from light and humidity.
