## 2. Before you take the medicine: Do not use the medicine if:

## vou are hypersensitive (allergic) to the active ingredient or to any of the other ingredients of this medicine.

 vou are breastfeeding or in your last trimester of pregnancy. you have had in the past an allergic reaction when taking

a medicine for pain relief, inflammation or fever, such as: diclofenac, ibuprofen or acetylsalicylic acid (a substance

used to prevent blood clots formation). The reactions can include: asthma, wheezing, skin rash, facial swelling, runny nose. If you are not sure, consult your doctor.

vou suffer from a castric or intestinal ulcer.

 vou suffer from bleeding of the digestive system. the symptoms can include: blood in the stools or black stools. you suffer from severe liver or kidney disease.

vou suffer from severe heart failure. vou have recently undergone or are about to undergo heart

do not take simultaneously with other medicines of the NSAIDs group. you suffer from ischemic heart disease or from cerebrovascular disease or peripheral artery disease (e.g. if you have suffered in the past from a heart attack, stroke or obstruction of arteries leading to the heart, brain or legs).
