RISEDRONATE TEVA® 35 mg Tablets

COMPOSITION

Each tablet contains: Risedronate Sodium 35 mg

Inactive ingredients:

Lactose monohydrate, pregelatinized starch, maize starch, colloidal silicon dioxide, sodium stearyl fumarate, magnesium stearyl fumarate, magnesium stearate, polyvinyl alcohol, titanium dioxide (E171), macrogol, talc, iron oxide yellow (E172), iron oxide red (E172).

Each tablet contains 139.9 mg lactose.

THERAPEUTIC GROUP

Risedronate belongs to a group of medicines called bisphosphonates.

THERAPEUTIC ACTIVITY

Risedronate is used to treat and prevent osteoporosis in postmenopausal women and for treatment of osteoporosis in men at high risk of fractures.

WHEN SHOULD THE PREPARATION NOT BE USED?

Do not use Risedronate if you are pregnant, planning to become pregnant or breastfeeding. Do not use Risedronate if you are

sensitive to any of its ingredients.
Do not take this medicine if you are unable to remain in an upright position (standing or sitting) for at least 30 minutes after taking the

medicine. Do not use this medicine if you have difficulty swallowing for any

Do not use this medicine if you are suffering from hypocalcemia (a low blood calcium level).

Do not use this medicine in patients suffering from severe renal failure (creatinine clearance less than 30 ml/min).

This medicine contains lactose therefore should not be used if you suffer from problems of galactose intolerance, lactase deficiency, or glucose and lactose malabsorption.

Do not take this medicine without consulting a doctor before consulting a doctor starting treatment

If you are suffering or have suffered in the past from impaired function of the kidney, the esophagus, from difficulty swallowing, if you are unable to sit or stand in an upright position. If you are suffering or have suffered in the past from swelling, pain or numbness of the jaw, loosened teeth or tooth loss, if you are under dental treatment or will undergo dental surgery, if you have an imbalance of minerals in the blood (such as lack of vitamin D or parathyroid hormone, both leading to a low blood calcium level). **WARNINGS**

If you are sensitive to any type of food or medicine, inform your doctor before commencing treatment with this medicine.

It is recommended to undergo a dental check-up prior to commencing treatment with the medicine in patients with risk factors, such as: cancer patients, patients receiving chemotherapy or radiotherapy, patients receiving corticosteroids, patients with poor oral hygiene. Inform your dentist that you are being treated with risedronate before starting dental treatment. Patients on long term treatment

Patients on long term treatment with this medicine may suffer from fracture of the thigh bone (see Side Effects section).

DRUG INTERACTIONS

If you are taking another concomitantly or if you just finished treatment drug have with another medicine, including non prescription medication or nutritional inform the attending supplements, doctor, in order to prevent hazards or lack of efficacy arising from drug interactions.

Allow a lapse of at least 30 minutes between taking Risedronate Teva® and taking other medications or any food (including vitamins, herbal supplements and medicines obtained without prescription). This medicine is effective only when

taken on an empty stomach.

SIDE EFFECTS

In addition to the desired effect of the medicine, adverse reactions may occur during the course of using this medicine, for example: gastrointestinal disturbances, such as: stomach ache, indigestion, bloating (flatulence), diarrhea, feeling sick, constipation, headache, pain in your joints, muscles or bones.

Pain or difficulties when swallowing inflammation or ulcer of t esophagus, chest pain, new worsened heartburn (rare): stop treatment and refer to your doctor immediately!

Inflammation of the small intestine, of the stomach, of the tongue or the eyes (pain and redness often accompanied by visual disturbances) (rare): stop treatment and refer to (rare):

your doctor. Skin irritation or rash (rare): continue treatment and refer to your doctor immediately.

Abnormal liver function tests, liver function disorders, hair loss (rare): refer to your doctor immediately.

Thigh pain, weakness or discomfort may be an early indication of a possible fracture of the thigh bone: refer to your doctor immediately.

In the event that you experience side effects not mentioned in this leaflet, or if there is a change in your general health, consult your doctor immediately.

DOSAGE

Dosage is according to doctor's instructions only. Do not exceed the recommended dosage.

Take one Risedronate Teva® 35 mg tablet once a week, whilst you are in an upright position (sitting or standing), with a full glass of tap water (not mineral water, not tea/coffee and not juice).

Do not lie down for 30 minutes after taking this medicine (in order to avoid heartburn).

Swallow the tablet first thing upon getting up in the morning, at least 30 minutes before having breakfast, before drinking any beverage (except for tap water) or taking any other medicine. medicine.

Choose one day of the week that best fits your schedule and take one Risedronate Teva® 35 mg tablet, on your chosen day each week.

your chosen day each week.

This medicine is not usually intended for administration to children under 18 years of age.

This medicine is to be taken at specific time intervals as determined by the attending doctor.

If you forget to take this medicine on your chosen day, take the tablet on the morning of the day after you remember, then return to taking one tablet once a week, on your chosen day as originally scheduled.

Never take two tablets in one day.

Never take two tablets in one day. During treatment with this medicine take care to eat a diet rich in calcium and vitamin D, such as dairy products.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

<u>Do not</u> chew or suck! <u>Do not</u> crush or divide the tablet! Swallow the tablet with a full glass of tap water only (see

Do not hold the tablet in your mouth longer than the time required for swallowing.

Failure to follow these instructions for the intake of this medicine may increase the risk of damaging the esophagus.

as instructed by the doctor. Even if there is an improvement in your health, do not discontinue use

of this medicine without consulting your doctor
